The ingredients that make up your electric bill

Delivery Charges

Charges for delivering electricity from your supplier to your address, including:

- Distribution, transmission and transition
- Metering, billing and customer service
- Renewable energy and efficiency programs

* Some delivery charges are incurred per kWh, and some are fixed.

Power Supply Charges

You can choose who supplies your electricity: your electric company, or a competitive supplier.

Your supplier buys its power wholesale, so your supply rate/kWh may vary depending on the electricity market conditions.

Other Charges/Adjustments

Compensation for paperless billing and bill credits (e.g. solar net metering credits)
